Mon 7th Sept.

Leaving Cert Results Portal opens at 9am. You need your examination number/password to access your calculated grades. If you have any issues with the Portal, call the Portal helpline on: 1800 111135/36. You should not go to your school. Instead ring them if you have a query or ask a Career expert for advice. UCAS offers for colleges in the UK will also be out on Monday morning.

Friday 11th Sept

CAO round one offers will be available online from 2pm. You have until 3pm on Wednesday 16th Sept to accept this offer. If the offer you get isn't your first choice, you still may get your first choice in Round 2 or subsequent rounds. If you wish to defer your offer, ring the admissions office at the specific third level college immediately and speak to them about it.

The Portal will then reopen on Monday 14th Sept at 9am when students can request a clerical appeal of their calculated grades. This appeal will solely check that all Information and data has been submitted and transferred properly. You can apply for this appeal up to 5pm on Wednesday 16th Sept. The Portal will show exact percentages in each subject.

If you choose to sit the exams in November, your points achieved will be used for access to third level in Sept 2021, where you will be competing for places with the class of 2021.
